Creper stool: The design of our stools is based on the old 'creper stool' – sitting around the fire folks would creep closer as it died down. Stools are made from recycled pine pews.

Beech clock: This elegant and simple design uses planed beech. The wood is worked to a velvet finish to highlight its natural grain.
